Gary Dyak

Gary Dyak was born in Johnstown, Pennsylvania. He joined the Army and was stationed in Turkey for three years. Moving to San Diego in 1976, Gary worked for General Atomic producing fuel for nuclear reactors. Gary began his medical career in the Army Reserves. He received his nursing degree through Grossmont College and worked in the medical field for 30 years; primarily in virology research at UCSD.

At the age of 50 Gary began taking evening classes at City College and earned an Associate degree in Fine Art. Gary works in several mediums including, graphite, colored pencil, ballpoint pen, and acrylics. He has exhibited in several San Diego venues which include City and Mesa College, the Del Mar fair and the William D. Cannon Art Gallery Biennial Exhibits. He has also exhibited in Los Angeles and Las Vegas. Mr. Dyak is a member of the Colored

Pencil Society of America, West Coast Drawing, San Diego Drawing Guild, and is a board member of the Foothills Artist Association.

Sharon Meng

Sharon Meng was born in New York and raised as an Army brat. She attended nursing school, worked in an IVF program as well as in Labor and Delivery and eventually went back to school to obtain a degree as a Nurse Midwife. While raising a family and pursuing a career in midwifery , she created small works in fiber and beads. Once she retired, she began to draw in colored pencil. Recently, she has been exploring watercolor.

Sharon is primarily self-taught but has attended a number of workshops in colored pencil techniques. She is a member of the Foothills Art Association, which she serves as Membership Chair, and a member of the Colored Pencil Society of America. She has exhibited in a number of shows and has had her art recognized in the Doggone Dog Show as well as the Cypress Art Gallery. She has also had a piece published in "CP Treasures, Volume 8". FOOTHILLS ART ASSOCIATION MARCH 2023 BOARD MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 12:30 March 13th, 2023.

Attendees: Peggy Connolly, Sharon Meng, Gary Dyak, Barbara Drews, Bob Pinner, Bonnie Owen, Roberta Labastida and Roz Oserin.

- 1. The minutes from February 2023 were reviewed and approved.
- 2. The motion to amend the FAA Bylaws to read: Standing Rules For Exhibits, Section I / Rules Governing Monthly Exhibits / Acceptable Work / Paragraph C to read; No craft including metal work, rock work, glass work, fiber work, paper sculpture, ceramics, reprints or reproductions of original artwork, or photography are permitted. These are permitted in the Expanded Media Exhibit in March. The Exhibits Department will be the final judge as to the acceptability of all media, including mixed media work employing one or more of the aforementioned craft media. The motion was approved at the February Board meeting. The motion was voted on and passed at the February General Members meeting.
- 3. Roz motioned that members submit up to two pieces of art for the members general meeting. Two pieces of artwork may be submitted for the Old Masters Show and a reference photo of the Masters artwork will accompany the members' representation of their work. For Juried shows, the following will apply; The Annual Juried Member Show (April) 4 pieces can be entered but the judge can only accept two artworks. Small Image Show (September) members may enter up to 4 art pieces. Wildlife in Art show (November) 4 pieces of art can be entered online only and the judge can choose 2 pieces per member. Bonnie seconded the motion and the motion passed. A Prospectus for each juried show will be sent to all members two months prior to the show.
- 4. Training for the members to understand and use Google Drive, Calendy for Gallery sitting, how to take and ready photos for shows will be offered. Dates and times for training will be forthcoming.
- 5. The Board will look into the best way to repair or replace the chair and table rack
- 6. Sharon is in the process of revamping membership renewal and prorating dues.
- 7. Roberta is retiring from the Take-in committee. Bob motioned that she be given Emeritus status. Gary seconded the motion and it was approved.

The next Board meeting will be held on April 3rd, 2023 at 12:00.

8. The meeting was adjourned at 1:30

Responsibilities include:

Arrive 15 minutes early to prepare gallery.

Complete intake document on the computer, print cards, number paintings, carry all paintings to and from gallery area Sign up gallery sitters on computer.

General cleanup / putting away tables and chairs etc.

- This is usually done on the first Thursday of every month and the time is determined by the time of year.

Responsibilities include:

Under the direction of the committee lead, paintings and cards are placed appropriately for design purposes. Any residual paintings need to be placed on the back rack with cardboard in between for safe keeping. A list of all residual paintings should be made for the back rack and once every two months those people should be called and reminded to pick up their paintings. A full membership list with phone numbers is available in a book at the front desk.
