Thank you so much Bonnie for your time and effort, we truly appreciate what you have done for us! We are so glad you will continue to be a member and now have some real time to paint!

Renee Ciufo will also be stepping down as a board member. Renee has been on the board for more than five years and performed the role of Historian. Additionally, Renee was our Gallery Coordinator, a time-consuming job that requires a lot of time on the phone, checking the website and more. Renee would often fill in sitting at the gallery when someone couldn't make it and gave of her time generously. She started our social media campaign, which again requires an enormous amount of time and energy. Social media has given us more exposure to the outside world. Renee, you have done so much for the gallery, so thank you, thank you, thank you! Hopefully you will also have more time to paint! You will both be sorely missed.

I am happy to report that some new members have stepped up to the plate and will be joining the board in different capacities. Elections for new board members will take place at our meeting in June, and I can't wait to announce them as part of our team!

We will be raising our membership fee by \$10 dollars across the board except for our youth price, which will remain at \$20.00. Dramatic increases on our electric bill, WiFi expenses, and increased costs of supplies have impacted our overhead to run the gallery. FAA MEMBERSHIP NEWS

We are very pleased to have you as a member of the Foothills Art Association, and look forward to another wonderful year together. We hope you are enjoying the many benefits of Foothills membership.

Please note that rising overhead costs have necessitated increasing dues by \$10 at every level except the junior level. Thank you for understanding.

Please keep in mind that we have four levels of membership: Junior membership is for members 12-18 years old (\$20); Associate members (\$35) can attend meetings and receive the newsletter but may not display their artwork in the Gallery; Regular membership (\$45) adds the ability to hang artwork in the monthly shows; Enhanced membership (\$55) includes the above privileges plus a gallery on our website to display their artwork. **Changes in dues amounts are effective immediately.**

Upon consideration, the Board has decided that given the resources currently available, it is not feasible to change the renewal process at this time. Therefore, we will continue with the current process.

Renewal is encouraged in June. For those who joined in other months during the year, you will receive a reminder letter the month before your renewal is due.

The meeting was called to order at 12:00pm on May 1st, 2023.

Attendees: Peggy Connolly, Sharon Meng, Gary Dyak, Dawn Ivy, Lorna Farmer, Barbara Drews, Bob Pinner, Judy Sawyer, Roz Oserin, and Bonnie Owen.

- 1. April's Minutes were reviewed and Approved.
- 2. The Treasurer's Report was reviewed and approved. Roz reported with the increases in utilities, WiFi, Website and rent we are currently paying out more than we are taking in. She motioned to change Article VIII Dues, in the By-Laws so that Membership dues would be increased as follows: Enhanced \$55.00, Active \$45.00, Associate \$35.00 and Junior Membership will remain at \$20.00. Peggy seconded the motion and it was unanimously passed. Peggy will bring the motion of change to the Members' Meeting to be voted on.
- 3. Roz also requested that we re-institute the practice of requesting that the Demonstrating Artist donates a piece of artwork to be raffled off at the meeting. It was agreed upon by the board.
- 4. Lorna Farmer presented her credentials and expressed her desire to become the Social Media Director. Dawn Ivy also expressed a desire to become our new Newsletter Editor. Peggy made a motion to accept Dawn and Lorna into those positions and Roz seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- 5. A discussion of reorganizing the responsibilities of the board and committees was tabled until next month.

The next Board Meeting will be held June 5th, 2023 at 12:00pm.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:30pm.

When you bring your work to the Gallery on take-in day, you will need two entry forms for each piece you are submitting. Please print and fill out the Entry Forms below or create your own. Attach one to the back of each piece, and give one (for each piece) to the volunteer accepting the work.
