The San Diego Drawing Guild (SDDG) is a group of graphite, pastel, and colored pencil artists who meet weekly in the Foothills Fine Art Gallery. SDDG is a diverse group whose artistic interests range from landscapes to flowers to portraits to more abstract representations. The group is unstructured, with no officers, and gathers for four hours each week to draw and enjoy the companionship of fellow artists. Members of the group, which has been meeting for approximately eight years, offer each other support,

encouragement and loving critique and have become good friends. When the pandemic required quarantine and the gallery closed, group members missed each other and the camaraderie they shared. They started meeting once a week on Zoom but the free 40 minute sessions just weren't enough togetherness so they purchased a business account, costing each member \$2 per week. In this way, they were able to continue their friendship and encourage artistic progress even as everyone coped with the reality of the pandemic. In the Zoom meetings, they continued to share their lives, their art, their frustrations and their joys.

The artists of SDDG come from varied backgrounds, including medicine, nursing, engineering, finance and business, and midwifery. Several members work in colored pencil (as well as other mediums) and are members of the Colored Pencil Society of America. Five members (Gary Dyak, Connie Grace, Carolyn Kenny, Rhonda Anderson and Aida Masliah) have been accepted in the Society's prestigious international show and some have won awards.

Demonstrating Artist LYLE RENNICK

Lyle Rennick is an accomplished portrait painter. Many of his wonderful portraits have been exhibited at the Foothills Fine Art Gallery. Lyle has won numerous awards for his paintings; most recently he won first place at our juried show and second place at the San Diego County Fair. Lyle received his degree in electrical engineering but continued to study Master painters for more than 25 years. During that time, he learned that the star of the painter is not the subject matter but the beauty of the painting on the canvas. His work stands out for its balance of hard and soft edges and light and dark values, bright and muted colors, and variety of shape. This can be clearly understood best when you see his work in person. He not only captures the person's features, he shows us an emotional insight into who they are. His method and approach are a unique combination of impressionism and realism.





We are excited to have Lyle at the Foothills Fine Art Gallery for a Portrait Demo, with a live model, on October 5 and a Portrait Workshop on October 7. We will be able to experience his unique approach firsthand.



Portrait Demo with Lyle Rennick





SHOW DETAILS:

23rd Annual Community Art Show Presented by the Chula Vista Art Guild October 14 – 28, 2023

Bonita Museum and Cultural Center, 4355 Bonita Road, Bonita, CA 91902 Museum Hours: Wednesday – Saturday, 10am – 4pm

AWARDS:

First Place: \$300, Second Place: \$200, Third Place: \$100 Honorable Mentions (2): \$25 each

ELIGIBILITY:

- This juried exhibition is open to all San Diego County artists, age 18 or older.
- Work must be original, not created as a student or workshop project.
- This is a community exhibition that includes families and children. Artwork containing nudity, sexual acts, gore, or violence will not be accepted.

ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS:

- All artwork must be dry, ready for exhibition and free of defects.
- Safety wire must be attached 1/3 of the distance down from the top of the frame. No saw-tooth hangers are accepted.
- Artwork, including frames, may not be larger than 30" x 40" or smaller than 11" x 14."
- Glass will not be accepted in any framed artwork larger than 24" x 30."
- Gallery-wrapped artwork (unframed) must have painted edges and no staples showing.
- All artwork must be labeled on the back with the artist's name, phone number, title of artwork, and asking price (or NFS).

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS & INFORMATION:

- A maximum of three paintings per artist is allowed. Due to limited space, only 60 paintings will be accepted.
- Entries must be hand-delivered on October 14th from 10am to 12pm to the Bonita Museum at 4355 Bonita Road, Bonita, CA.
- Accepted Entries: All accepted entries will be displayed at the Bonita Museum from October 14 to 28. An Awards Reception will be held on Friday, October 21 from 5:30pm to 7:30pm.
- Artwork may not be removed until the last day of the show.
- A fee of \$10 per day will be charged for work not picked up on time (4pm, Saturday, October 28).
- NOTE: Any artist whose entry is not accepted will be notified by 12pm on October 14. The artwork must be picked up by 1pm.

ENTRY FEES:

- Members: First Painting: \$25, Second Painting: \$15, Third Painting: \$10
- Non- Members: First Painting: \$30, Second Painting: \$15, Third Painting: \$10

FOOTHILLS ART ASSOCIATION September 2023 Board Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 9:57 a.m. on August 28, 2023.

Attendees: Peggy Connolly, Celeste Schwartz, Judy Sawyer, Sharon Meng, Dawn Ivy, Barbara Drews, and Lloyd Smith

- 1. The minutes from August 2023 were reviewed and approved.
- 2. Peggy discussed the updated bylaws and feedback she has received. She is pleased with the updates, as the bylaws are now more current and accurate. Small edits were discussed and will be reviewed by a lawyer before sending to membership for approval.
- 3. Peggy shared updates on the Wildlife in Art Show/Reception. She has compiled a planning team that will begin meeting this week to work on securing sponsorships, publicity, and event logistics.
- 4. Celeste shared updates on the grant writing process and steps needed to be successful. She also stated that the Volunteer Form, Volunteer Guide, and Policy and Procedure Guide are completed and going through final edits. The goal of creating these documents is to provide accessible information for members and clear guidelines for the future success of the organization.
- 5. The group discussed the importance of improving community outreach to gain awareness of FAA. Plans were discussed to reach out to members and utilize Footnotes to encourage involvement.
- 6. Sharon reported that we currently have 177 members. She continues to send out monthly reminder letters with a future goal of having all members renew in June.
- 7. The group recently decided to add a donation button to the website to make donating easier. The group reviewed the wording for the online donation page and it was approved. The approved content will be sent to Bob and the web consultant to post online. The group also discussed a way to create a list of donations received in order to send out tax letters at the end of the calendar year.
- 8. The group revisited the idea of adding a liability clause on the online membership page. Celeste will review the wording and discuss with Bob to determine if we can incorporate the information on the online membership page.
- 9. The group agreed that the recent loitering concern on the patio area has been resolved. It was decided that the key lock box would remain in place at this time.
- 10. Lloyd discussed budget questions regarding supplies for the gallery. The group agreed that the organization would continue to provide basic items needed at the gallery.
- 11. The group discussed concerns about food being left out that may attract pests. Peggy will confirm if the cleaning crew is still providing service twice a month.
- 12. A checklist was created in case an incident or injury occurs at the gallery to ensure volunteers know the appropriate action steps, if needed. The checklist will be finalized and posted in the gallery.
- 13. The group discussed inviting all committee chairs to the next board meeting to discuss upcoming art shows.

The next Board Meeting will be held October 2, 2023 at 10:00 a.m.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:15 a.m.
