# Demonstrating Artist LINDA MULLEN

An award-winning watercolorist, **Linda Mullen** began her creative career painting in transparent watercolor more than twenty years ago.

Her education came primarily through personal experimentation with the aid of books, workshops and personal conversations with successful artists.

Linda's artwork has received awards in gallery exhibitions such as the San Diego Watercolor Society, and Kaiser Permanente has several of her pieces in their permanent collection.

Linda offers private and semi-private lessons to painters at all skill levels, she is a signature member of the Western Federation of Watercolor Societies and the San Diego Watercolor Society, and is also a Bible teacher, speaker, and ordinary person who shares her life experiences to encourage others. She is the author of Unglued, a tool to help you forgive and be free, Dancing with God, and Creative Spiritual Warfare.

We are excited to have Linda share with us her technique for "Painting White Flowers in Watercolor." Her demonstration will be Thursday, November 2 during the general meeting, beginning at 5:30pm, so come early for a good seat and a little socializing beforehand.

The workshop will be **Sunday**, **November 5 from 1:00pm-4:00pm**, and is open to all experience levels.







# FOOTHILLS ART ASSOCIATION October 2023 Board Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, October 2, 2023.

Attendees: Peggy Connolly, Michele Barbour, Celeste Schwartz, Lloyd Smith, Jo Ann Bray, Judy Sawyer, Barbara Drews, Linda Morton, Sharon Meng, Dawn Ivy, Roz Oserin, Lorna Farmer, and Bob Pinner

- 1. The September Board Meeting Minutes were reviewed via email and approved.
- 2. Peggy welcomed the Committee Chairs and the group discussed possible ways to improve the current procedures.
- 3. The group discussed the take-in process and decided to change the take-in end time to 5:00pm to allow the take-in committee to participate in the members' meetings. The group also decided to send take-in rule reminders to members to help streamline the take-in process. Additional recommendations will be provided for board review at a later date.
- 4. The group discussed the Demo Artist program and the Chair stated that the process is going great and that adding committee members helps expand the options of demo artists.
- 5. The group discussed Gallery Sitting and the Chair stated that members are signing up and coverage is good. Weekly art groups are providing coverage for many of the sitting shifts. She stated that members want to see the schedule. The group discussed the option of having a printed schedule with phone numbers so sitters can make reminder calls to the sitters scheduled for the next day. The process to cancel a scheduled sitting was reviewed.
- 6. The Featured Artist program was discussed and the list of featured artists for 2024 was reviewed. The list is nearly full, so the process to apply to become a Featured Artist will be shared in an upcoming issue of Footnotes.
- 7. Peggy provided an update on the Wildlife in Art Show/Reception. She stated that fundraising is going well and the online registration is now open, after resolving some challenges. She has compiled a planning team that is now meeting weekly to work on sponsorships, publicity, and event logistics. She stated that the San Diego Drawing Group will help with hospitality, and there is a need for additional help from Board Members on the day of the event. A list of event day tasks will be compiled to solicit volunteers for the event. The event will expand to the parking lot area to accommodate the crowds. Peggy made a motion to approve the rental of 80 chairs for the event, Lorna seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved. This will be a rain or shine event.
- 8. The group discussed adding suggested themes to the 2024 Art Shows. The group reviewed a list of possible theme options and individually voted for their top six themes. Descriptions will be added to the top six themes and reviewed at the next Board Meeting. The group also discussed new award ideas and adding another open show to improve community awareness and increase membership.
- 9. Peggy stated that the updated bylaws are in the final review stage. She also mentioned that the Board is working on an operating budget and other financial documents needed to apply for grant funding. Roz stated that she created a profit and loss statement for the Wildlife in Art event.
- 10. The group discussed the inventory of gallery supplies needed for members' meetings and the Wildlife in Art Reception.
- 11. The group discussed ways to improve attendance for the Life Drawing group. An email with information about the group will be sent to members and shared in the Footnotes.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:35 a.m.

The next Board Meeting will be held Monday, November 6, 2023 at 10:00 a.m.
